- Adults - 20p per entry Children - free.
- Certificates will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- There will also be a prize for the most points in each section. Presentation at 3.30pm on show day.
- All exhibits must be brought/staged to Ord Statter Pavilion between 1:00pm - 5:30pm on Friday 17th July, or 7:30 - 9:15am on 18th July (show day).
- Judging will take place between 9:30am-11:00am on 18th July.
- No entry to the Ord Statter/exhibit marquees while judging takes place.
- All entries to be collected between 3.30 - 4:30pm on 18th July.
